- All the main events for the One day programme will be held in the city-centre church of St Martin in the Bull Ring. This includes registration, morning programme, lunch, midday prayer, afternoon session, evening prayer.
- St Martin in the Bull Ring (http://www.bullring.org/) is in the calm shopping centre area of the city. It is accessible from New Street Station (5 minutes on foot) only crossing one road which has pedestrain lights.
- The second part of the afternoon programme may, **at the discretion and responsibility of the group leader**, be spent at another city-centre venue. In particular, the workshop on icons will be reserved for 16-18s. This will be held at Carrs Lane Church Centre (5 minutes on foot; two streets, both with pedestrian lights to cross).
- All the leaders of the 16-18 programme have DBS checks.
- Both a doctor and a qualified child counsellor will be available during the day at St Martin's.
