**10:15 | S1** “What does the inner life transform in my relationship with God and in my relationship with others?” | With Bishop Benoît Rivière (France)

*Benoît Rivière is Bishop of Autun, Chalon and Mâcon, the region where Taizé is located. In this workshop, he will shed light on the inner life from the experience of the desert fathers and the great monastic tradition.*

**10:15 | 15** “Social Justice in the Textile Industry – Interactive Workshop” | With Barbara Alger (United States).

*Barbara Alger is an ambassador for A Rocha, a Christian organization working on nature conservation, church engagement and environmental education. In this interactive workshop on the textile industry and its ecological and social impact, we will discuss what we can do individually and collectively to change our consumption habits.*

**10:15 | P** “Understanding grief and finding ways to better deal with it – Practical workshop” | With Christiane Steffens-Dhaussy (Germany / Luxembourg).

*Christiane Steffens-Dhaussy, German psychologist, author of a book about grief in the hospital setting, will speak about grief. We all experience grief in our lives: the grief of a separation, the loss of a life project, mourning a loved one who has died... What kind of resources can help me to cope better with grief? How can I support someone who is grieving?*

**10:15 | 10** “From Famine to Feast – Climate Stories Inspired by Joseph” | With Jeremy Brown (United Kingdom).

*Jeremy Brown is doing a PhD in climate storytelling at Southampton University. This workshop is an opportunity to learn from how Joseph, the Biblical hero in Genesis, prepared Egypt for a coming food crisis, and to apply this to climate change in the XXI century. It will be an interactive workshop with a chance to imagine your own climate story. In addition, the workshop will present different solutions to improve the resilience of agriculture in the context of climate change.*

**15:15 | 10** “Eco-spirituality, a quest rooted in the heart of today's challenges. The experience of the Maison de Tobie in the Paris region”. | With Daniel Gouilly (France).

*Daniel Gouilly is involved in the St John Bosco Salesian network. In this workshop, he will introduce us to the "House of Tobie", created in 1989 on the initiative of Father Benoît Billot, a Benedictine monk. La "Maison de Tobie" listens to the teachings of the Fathers of the Church as well as the treasures of Eastern spirituality, in particular the Zen way, and is now committed to the eco-spirituality approach.*

**15:15 | M** “Christian-Muslim Friendship – Experiences of Living Together Today” | With Ferenc Hardi (Hungary / France).

*“Discovering others, living with them, listening to them, letting them shape you as well. This does not mean losing one's identity or rejecting one's values. It means conceiving of a plural, non-exclusive humanity.” (Pierre Claverie, bishop of Oran). The workshop will be held by Ferenc Hardi (Hungary/France).*

**15:15 | 15** “Is it possible to live your faith while developing a business? Startups, Ideation and Christian Values” | With Christopher Bird, Hania and Joshua Snyder (UK/Poland).

*A workshop on integrating faith on work, telling the story of building a company, TimeNavi, that helps people understand their time and focus on priorities. Discussions and content about balancing business and ethics, building a culture rooted in Christian values and practical tips on how to live out your faith at work in what you do and how you do it.*
