Daily Bible readings

1 John 17:11-21
SUN Jesus prayed for his disciples, saying: Father, may they all be one, just as you are in me and I am in you, so that they may also be in us and the world may believe that you sent me.

2 Wisdom 6:12-16
Mon The wisdom of God is readily seen by those who love her. Those who seek her will find her.

3 Luke 24:13-35
Tue While two disciples were on their way to Emmaus, talking together about all that had happened, Jesus himself came up and walked with them.

4 John 6:41-47
Wed Jesus said: It is written in the prophets, "They will all be taught by God." Everyone who listens to the Father and learns from him comes to me.

5 Exodus 22:20-21
Thu Do not mistreat or oppress the strangers in your midst, for you too were once strangers in the land of Egypt.

6 Psalms 55:17-19
Fri To God I call and he saves me, evening, morning and at noon. God's peace delivers my soul, for he hears my cry.

7 Ephesians 1:3-14
Sat God chose us in Christ, before the world was made, to be holy and faultless before him in love.

8 Psalms 104
SUN PENTECOST
The earth is full of your works, Lord. You send out your Spirit and life begins, you renew the face of the earth.

9 1 Timothy 4:12-16
Mon You have in you a spiritual gift which was given to you. Do not neglect it.

10 John 4:4-26
Tue Jesus said: God is spirit, and those who worship must worship in spirit and truth.

11 1 Corinthians 12:12-27
Wed As with the human body which is a unity although it has many parts, so it is with Christ. We were baptised into one body in a single Spirit, and we were all given the same Spirit to drink.

12 Romans 8:14-17
Thu You did not receive a spirit which makes you a slave to fear again; you received the spirit of adoption by which we cry out, "Abba! Father!"

13 Romans 5:1-11
Fri Our hope will not let us down, because the love of God has been poured into our hearts by the Holy Spirit which has been given to us.

14 Ephesians 5:14-20
Sat Let yourselves be filled by the Spirit. Sing and make music in your heart to the Lord.

15 Proverbs 8:12-31
SUN The Wisdom of God says: The Lord created me at the beginning of his work, the first of his acts of long ago. I was beside him, like a master worker; and I was daily his delight, rejoicing before him always, at play everywhere on his earth and delighting in human beings.

16 Jeremiah 14:8-9
Mon You are our hope, O God. You are among us and we are called by your name.

17 Psalms 119:81-88
Tue My soul longs for your salvation, Lord. I hope in your word.

18 Matthew 9:35—10:8
Wed At the sight of the crowds Jesus was moved to compassion, because they were like sheep without a shepherd.

19 Mark 14:12-26
Thu As Jesus was eating with his disciples, he took a loaf of bread, and after blessing it he broke it, gave it to them, and said, "Take it; this is my body."

20 Philippians 2:1-11
Fri Being in every way like a human being, Christ Jesus was humbler yet, and became obedient to death, death on a cross. Therefore God raised him high and gave him the name which is above all other names.

21 Romans 10:11-13
Sat There is no difference between persons: all have the same Lord, who generously blesses all who call on him.

22 Luke 9:11-17
SUN Taking five loaves and two fish and looking up to heaven, Jesus said the blessing over them; then he broke them and handed them to his disciples to distribute among the people. They all ate as much as they wanted.

23 Isaiah 30:18-21
Mon The One who teaches you will hide no more and you will see him with your eyes. Your ears will hear a voice behind you, saying, "This is the way, walk in it."

24 Acts 13:22-26
Tue To keep his promise, God has raised up one of David's descendants, Jesus, as Saviour, whose coming was prepared by John when he proclaimed a baptism of repentance to all the people.

25 Mark 12:1-12
Wed Jesus said of himself: The stone which the builders rejected has become the cornerstone: this is the Lord's doing.

26 Hebrews 4:12-16
Thu The word of God is alive and active. It discerns the thoughts and desires of the human heart.

27 2 Corinthians 5:18-21
Fri In Christ, God has reconciled us to himself and entrusted us with the ministry of reconciliation.

28 Nehemiah 8:8-12
Sat Do not be sad or dejected: the joy of God is your strength.

29 Matthew 16:13-20
SUN Jesus asked his disciples: "Who do people say I am?" "Some say John the Baptist," they answered, "some Elijah, and others Jeremiah or one of the prophets." "But you," he said, "who do you say I am?" Peter spoke up and said, "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God."

30 Wisdom 1:11-15
Mon God did not make death and takes no pleasure in the destruction of the living. God created all things for life.

These short readings are those read, day by day, at community prayer in Taizé. The Bible reference given indicates a slightly longer passage.
