Daily Bible readings

John 17:11-21 **SUN** Iesus prayed for his disciples, saving: Father, may they all be one. just as you are in me and I am in you, so that they may also be in us and the world may believe that you sent me.

Wisdom 6:12-16 **Mon** The wisdom of God is readily seen by those who love her. Those who seek her will find her.

Luke 24:13-35 Tue While two disciples were on their way to Emmaus, talking together about all that had happened, Jesus himself came up and walked with them.

John 6:41-47 Wed Jesus said: It is written in the prophets, "They will all be taught by God." Everyone who listens to the Father and learns from him comes to me.

Exodus 22:20-21 Thu Do not mistreat or oppress the strangers in vour midst, for you too were once strangers in the land of Egypt.

Psalms 55:17-19 Fri To God I call and he saves me, evening, morning and at noon. God's peace delivers my soul, for he hears my cry.

Ephesians 1:3-14 **Sat** God chose us in Christ, before the world was made, to be holy and faultless before him in love.

8 Psalms 104 **SUN** PENTECOST The earth is full of your works, Lord. You send out your Spirit and life begins, you renew the face of the earth.

1 Timothy 4:12-16 Mon You have in you a spiritual gift which was given to you. Do not neglect it.

John 4:4-26 **Tue** Jesus said: God is spirit, and those who worship must worship in spirit and truth.

1 Corinthians 12:12-2.7 **Wed** As with the human body which is a unity although

it has many parts, so it is with Christ. We were baptised into one body in a single Spirit, and we were all given the same Spirit to drink.

Romans 8:14-17 Thu You did not receive a spirit which makes you a slave to fear again; you received the spirit of adoption by which we cry out, "Abba! Father!"

Romans 5:1-11 Fri Our hope will not let us down, because the love of God has been poured into our hearts by the Holy Spirit which has been given to us.

Ephesians 5:14-20 **Sat** Let vourselves be filled by the Spirit. Sing and make music in your heart to the Lord.

Proverbs 8:12-31 **SUN** The Wisdom of God says: The Lord created me at the beginning of his work, the first of his acts of long ago. I was beside him, like broke them and handed them a master worker; and I was daily his delight, rejoicing before him always, at play everywhere on his earth and delighting in human beings.

Jeremiah 14:8-9 Mon You are our hope. O God. You are among us and we are called by your name.

Psalms 119:81-88 **Tue** My soul longs for your salvation, Lord. I hope promise, God has raised up in your word.

Matthew 9:35-10:8 **Wed** At the sight of the crowds Iesus was moved to compassion, because they were like sheep without a shepherd.

Mark 14:12-26 **Thu** As Jesus was eating with his disciples, he took a loaf of bread, and after blessing it he broke it, gave it to them, and said, "Take it; this is my body."

Philippians 2:1-11 **Fri** Being in every way like a human being. Christ Jesus was humbler yet, and became obedient to death, death on a cross. Therefore God raised him high and gave him the name which is above all other names.

Romans 10:11-13 **Sat** There is no difference between persons: all have the same Lord, who generously blesses all who call on him.

Luke 9:11-17 **SUN** Taking five loaves and two fish and looking up to heaven. Iesus said the blessing over them: then he to his disciples to distribute among the people. They all ate as much as they wanted.

Isaiah 30:18-21 **Mon** The One who teaches vou will hide no more and you will see him with your eves. Your ears will hear a voice behind you, saving, "This is the way, walk in it."

Acts 13:22-26 Tue To keep his one of David's descendants, Jesus, as Saviour, whose coming was prepared by John when he proclaimed a baptism of repentance to all the people.

Mark 12:1-12 Wed Iesus said of himself: The stone which the builders rejected has become the cornerstone: this is the Lord's doing.

Hebrews 4:12-16 **Thu** The word of God is alive and active. It discerns the thoughts and desires of the human heart.

2 Corinthians 5:18-21 Fri In Christ, God has reconciled us to himself and entrusted us with the ministry of reconciliation.

Nehemiah 8:8-12 Sat Do not be sad or dejected: the joy of God is your strength.

These short readings are those read, day by day, at community prayer in Taizé. The Bible reference given indicates a slightly longer passage.

Matthew 16:13-20 **SUN** Jesus asked his disciples: "Who do people say I am?" "Some say John the Baptist." they answered. "some Elijah, and others Jeremiah or one of the prophets." "But you," he said, "who do you say I am?" Peter spoke up and said. "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God."

Wisdom 1:11-15 **Mon** God did not. make death and takes no pleasure in the destruction of the living. God created all things for life.
